From East: Route 128 to Route 11 in Alton, watch for junction of Route 140 to Gilmanton on left. Stay on Route 140 going across Route 107 and Route 106. At stop sign crossing Route 106 turn right onto Main Street. Watch for School Street on left. School is straight ahead.

From West: Route 11 through Franklin and Tilton, at McDonald's turn right onto Route 140, go about 5 miles to stop sign. Turn right onto Main Street then turn left onto School Street. School is straight ahead.

From North: Take Exit 20 off I-93. At lights, turn left. Take next right onto Route 140. Go approx. 5 miles. At stop sign turn right onto Main Street. Watch for School Street on left. School is straight ahead.

From South: See directions for North.

Follow Route 115 to its end and take a right onto Route 2 into Gorham, NH (approximately 13 miles)

At the stoplight take a left onto Route 16 into Berlin.

From Interstate 91 North

Take Route 91 North to exit 17 at Wells River, VT onto Route 302 at Woodsville, NH.

Take Route 302 to Littleton, NH passing through Littleton's Main St.

Then Route 116 leading out of Littleton to its end, in Jefferson, NH.

Take a right onto Route 2 into Gorham, NH (Follow the same directions as above from Gorham)

Go straight through the center of town for approximately 2 miles and look for the Pats Peak sign on your right. Take the right and follow the road to the Pats Peak entrance

From the North and East: Follow Interstate 93 South to 293 South

From the South and West: Follow Interstate 3/Everett Turnpike to 293 South

Then from 293 South (all directions):

Take the Brown Avenue, Exit #2. At the bottom of the exit ramp, make a right turn.

Continue on Brown Avenue until the 3rd traffic light. (Manchester Airport).

Make a right turn at this light.

Continue on this road (also called Brown Avenue, Hazelton Avenue, Charles Bancroft Highway and Route 3A) for approximately 3 miles.

Turn left onto Albuquerque Avenue (you'll see the Hidden Creek Golf Course).

Follow for approximately 3.5 miles. You will pass through 2 stop signs (the first is about 2.2 miles after turning onto Albuquerque, the second is 1.3 miles from there).

About 1.3 miles after the second stop sign you will see CHS on your left.

FROM THE NORTH:

Take 89 North from Concord to Route 202 West to Peterborough through Hillsborough, Antrim, etc. Staying on Route 202 West, you will go around the village of Peterborough and come to the intersection of Routes 101 and 202 (four way intersection with lights). Take a left (Route 202 West). Continue into Jaffrey. At traffic lights, take the diagonal left onto Stratton Road. The school is less than ¼ mile on your left. The High School is in back of the Middle School.

FROM THE SOUTH:

Take Route 202 East to Jaffrey. At the first set of lights, take a right. At the second set of lights, bear right onto Stratton Road. The school is less than ¼ mile on the left.

FROM THE WEST:

From Keene, take Route 101 East to Marlboro. After going through Marlboro, take a right onto Route 124 East to Jaffrey. Go straight at the first set of lights. Bear right at the second set of lights onto Stratton Road. The school is less than ¼ mile on your left.

FROM THE EAST:

Take Route 101 West to Peterborough and the four-way intersection with traffic lights (Routes 101 and 202). Take a left onto Route 202 West. Continue into Jaffrey. At traffic lights, take the diagonal left onto Stratton Road. The school is less than ¼ mile on your left. The High School is in back of the Middle School.

FROM THE NORTH AND EAST: Follow directions to Jaffrey. At second set of lights, go straight (Route 124 toward Keene). Approx. 2 miles from light, you will see a blinking yellow light (large white church on right). At bottom of hill after blinking light, take a right onto Dublin Road. Shattuck will be on your left.

FROM THE SOUTH: Follow directions into Jaffrey. At the first set of lights, take a left onto Route 124 toward Keene. Follow directions above.

FROM THE WEST: Approximately 10 miles from Marlboro (on Route 124 East), you will go down a series of hills. You will then be on an approximately ¼ mile flat. Just before you go up a steep hill with a curve to the right, take a left onto Dublin Road. Shattuck will be on your left. If you reach the blinking light at the top of the hill – turn around, you’ve gone too far!

FROM THE NORTH AND EAST: Follow directions into Jaffrey. At first set of lights, take immediate left onto East Main Street (Route 124). Go approximately ½ mile. (You will pass the Post Office on the right, then go down a short hill with a softball field on the right.) At the

bottom of the hill, take a right immediately after the softball field onto a narrow dirt road. The tennis courts are at the end.

FROM THE SOUTH AND WEST: Follow directions into Jaffrey. At the second set of lights, (a 5-way intersection) bear left onto Route 124 (Rite Aid on your left). Follow above directions.

You can also follow the directions to the High School, park in the school parking lot, and walk down the path and across the soccer field to the tennis courts. Even though the path is paved, it is quite steep.

From Laconia, Weirs Beach & Lakes Region - Take Route 3 South into Franklin - Just before reaching downtown Franklin you will travel down a long hill - at bottom of hill is a Shop Express gas station on left - Get in left-hand turn lane and go left on Prospect St (just before Shop Express gas station / look for Mojalaki sign on left) - Mojalaki Golf Club is 1 mile on the right.

From New London Area - Traveling South on Route 4/11 - Proceed left onto Route 11 (to Franklin) - Take a right on Route 3A South - Take a left at the traffic light onto Route 3 North - Proceed 4 miles through downtown Franklin and at Shop Express gas station (on right) turn right onto Prospect Street - Mojalaki Golf Club is 1 mile on the right.

From East: Route 128 to Route 11 through Alton. Go about 5 miles and turn left onto Route 11-A towards Gunstock and Gilford. Go approximately 6 miles. After the flashing light at Gilford Village take the next left onto Alvah Wilson Road (school entrance way.) School is ¼ mile on the left. The Gilford Middle School is the first building and Gilford High School is behind the middle school.

From West: Route 104. After you get off Route I-93 at the Bristol/New Hampton Exit 23 take a left back under I-93. Go approximately 4 miles. Watch for Meredith Center Road on the right. Take Meredith Center Road all the way to the end, about 5 miles. At the light, go straight through and pass Laconia Country Club – this is Elm Street. Follow Elm Street until the light, approximately 2 miles. At the light, take a right onto Union Avenue. Stay on Union Avenue and pass Laconia High School on the left. After passing LHS take a left at the light – Gilford Avenue. Follow Gilford Avenue – becomes Route 11 – for approximately 4 miles. On the right, take Alvah Wilson Road (school entrance way.) School is ¼ mile on the left. The Gilford Middle School is the first building and Gilford High School is behind the middle school.

From North: Follow Route I-93 until the Bristol/New Hampton Exit 23. Follow the directions above From West.

From South: Take Route I-93 to Exit 20. Take a left at the end of the ramp. Stay on Route 3 for about 8 miles. After the Belknap Mall take a right onto the Laconia/Gilford By-Pass. Take the second exit – Gilford/Gunstock. At the stop sign turn right onto Route 11. Go approximately 2 miles. On the right, take Alvah Wilson Road (school entrance way.) School is ¼ mile on the left. The Gilford Middle School is the first building and Gilford High School is behind the middle school.

From Keene - take Route 202/9 East toward Concord. Take the exit for 202/149 Antrim & Peterborough. At the bottom of the exit take a right. Take a left at the light (McDonalds on left). From I-93 South take Ashland Exit, take Route 3 South to Meredith.

Prescott Park is on the left as you enter downtown Meredith Area (before Police Station).
